There are just over 100 authentic covered bridges in the U.S. state of Vermont, giving the state the highest number of covered bridges per square mile in the United States. A covered bridge is considered authentic not due to its age, but by its construction.

The fifth Northfield bridge, the Stony Brook Covered Bridge, is representative of the end of the era of covered bridge construction in Vermont. Built in 1899, it was the last kingpost truss covered bridge built on a Vermont public highway.

Dating to 1852, the picturesque red bridge is located on the town green near the former home of painter Norman Rockwell, which is now the Norman Rockwell Studio and Inn : an ideal landing place for the night.
