Quid Pro Quo. Federal law recognizes two different sets of legal grounds for claiming sexual harassment under Title VII. 38 The first is quid pro quo. 39 Under the quid pro quo form of harassment, a person in authority, usually a supervisor, demands sexual favors of a subordinate as a condition of getting or keeping a job benefit. 40 The second, which we will discuss below, is a hostile work ...
